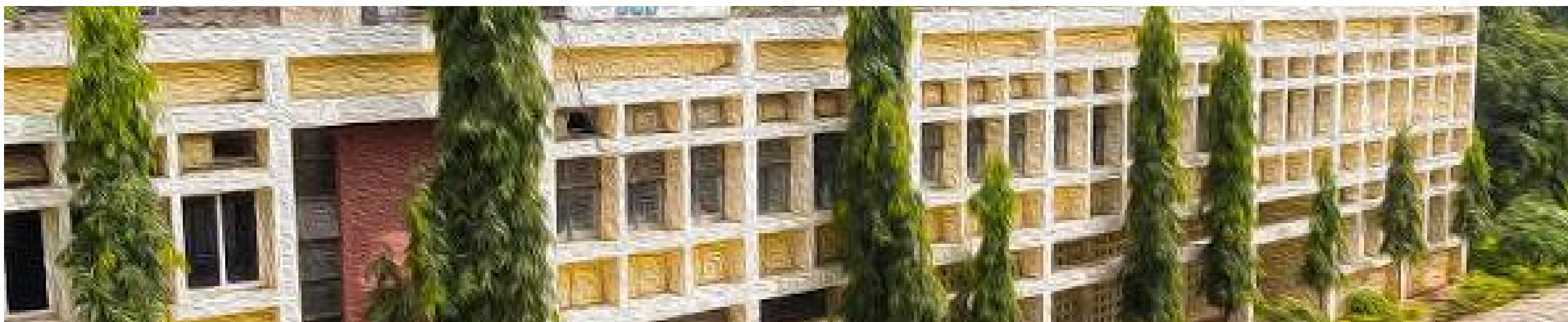

Guidelines for Abstract/Paper Submission

Authors are invited to submit an extended abstract of 2–4 pages (A4 size) using the following format:

- Font: Times New Roman
- Title: 14 pt., Bold
- Authors: 12 pt., with an asterisk (*) indicating the corresponding author
- Affiliation: 12 pt., Italic
- Corresponding author's email: Enclosed in parentheses immediately below the affiliation (e.g., e-mail for correspondence: admetconference2026@gmail.com)
- Abstract text: 12 pt.
- Acknowledgements (if any): Heading in Italics; text in normal 12 pt. font

Submission Guidelines:

Authors are requested to adhere to the following guidelines:

- The submitted work must be original and must not have been published or submitted elsewhere.
- The abstract should address topics related to Measurement Science within the scope of the conference.
- The abstract should present novel findings supported by experimental or analytical data and should not be limited to a conceptual proposal or work plan.
- For inclusion in the Conference Abstract Book, at least one author must be registered for the conference.
